## WWII Veteran and Tuskegee Airman to speak at Dr. MLK celebration in Portage

On 8 Mar 19, leaders of the City of Portage (MI) joined with the staff of the Air Zoo Aerospace and Science Museum to present its' annual Black History Month program in honor of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and featuring Lt. Col. Alexander Jefferson, of the Detroit Chapter of Tuskegee Airmen as the keynote speaker. Four of the planes used in training and combat are on display at the Air Zoo as well as a new, permanent Air Zoo exhibit, called Black Wings American Dreams of Flight, which features the Tuskegee Airmen. *With well over 500 people in attendance*, Jefferson, who was inducted into the Air Zoo's Michigan Aviation Hall of Fame in 1995, spoke of his experiences and engaged one on one afterwards.

## A Tuskegee Airman Remembers Those Who **Supported The Pilots And The** Country's Acknowledgment

A former Tuskegee airman says he and his fellow pilots suffered discrimination from their white counter parts, but ultimately proved they were as good as anyone else in protecting the country During World War II. Retired Lieutenant Colonel Alexander Jefferson spoke at an event at the Air Zoo Friday night. Jefferson is a native of Detroit. He was part of the 332nd Fighter Group. In 2007, more than 60 years after the end of World War II, Jefferson and others were at the White House to receive the Congressional Gold Medal. "Finally the country acknowledged 2007, awarding the Tuskegee Airmen with Congressional Gold Medals. Fellow Airman Dr. Roscoe Brown is at right. some of the misdeeds that the Tuskegee airmen under-CREDIT SUSAN WALSH/THE ASSOCIATED PRESS went." Jefferson says the pilots also relied on many others

to carry out their mission. "People in all occupations to support the guys who were flying." In August of 1944 German soldiers captured Jefferson after his plane was shot down and he became a prisoner of war. Jefferson says the Tuskegee Airmen were highly decorated: "We had guys who received the Purple Heart, which means they were injured. We had 25 men who got the Bronze Star for an act of courage." Jefferson received the Purple Heart in 2001 for injuries he suffered in 1944. Friday night's event at the Air Zoo is part of Black History Month and the Kalamazoo area's Martin Luther King Junior celebration. 

30th Annual Salute, Reception and Dinner

On 23 Feb 19, the Tuskegee Airmen National Historical Museum held their 30th Annual Salute, Reception and Dinner at Detroit's famed Charles H Wright Museum of African American History. The evening was a recognition of the 1949 Air Force Air Gunnery meet in which a delegation from the still segregated 332nd Fighter Group won the Conventional class. Although they score the most points of all 12 fighter groups represented, it was not a head-to-head competition with the 5 jet class groups that were there because the jet groups could not participate in the skip bombing part of the competition. Also, recognized that night was the opening of an exhibit about the 1949 competition located in the museum's Coleman A. Young room. Attendees also got a chance to see a new documentary that will be used in educational settings called Our Voices: Our Stories and featuring Detroit chapter's own LtCol (Ret) Harry T. Stewart, Jr and LtCol (Ret) Alexander Jefferson. The evening ended with a Q&A session with Stewart and LtCol (Ret) James Harvey of Denver. He and Stewart are two (2) of the four (4) pilots that represented the 332nd in the 1949 competition.


